Memorial Cross

Set tastefully on the eastern side of The Annunciation Church, the granite Memorial Cross. The Memorial Cross will be lit by night lights and provides the opportunity for family and loved ones to remember those that have departed this world to live an eternal life with The Lord our Father. The Memorial Cross will be symbolic in our Parish and will be part of relevant annual religious liturgy to celebrate and remember All Souls Day in November each year. The Memorial Cross and the names of the departed who will be inscribed on granite plaques placed on the cross will be blessed by our Parish Priest in an annual All Souls Day ceremony.

As a valued Parishioner, or simply as part of the Hectorville Catholic Community you have the opportunity to have a granite memorial plaque for you, your family and / or other loved ones to be affixed to the Memorial Cross. The plaques can be in memory of the departed or the living. Plaques for the departed will be affixed as soon as possible whilst plaques for the living will be affixed at the instructions of relevant family members. As the Memorial Cross will only cater for a limited number of plaques, plaques can be secured immediately and in advance and there is no limit on the number of plaques that can be secured.

The plaques will measure 15cm wide by 10cm high by 1cm thick and be Indian Black in colour and engraved with white writing.

As shown below, there are two options for plaque layout, individual and family. You must indicate which plaque you require when making your committment.

Plaques are \$300 each and includes engraving and affixing of the plaque on the Memorial Cross. Plaques will be affixed over. All plaques must be paid for in full at the time of committment. Cash, cheque and credit card payments are accepted at the Parish Office (Mon to Fri – 9.30am to 4pm). Electronic Funds Transfers (EFT) can be negotiated with the Parish Office.
