COMMUNION ANTIPHON:

REFLECTIONS- Our Lord Jesus Christ proclaims in today’s Gospel that He is the total satisfaction of our deepest human appetites: ‘I am the Bread from Heaven which gives life to the world.’ That ‘Life’ is nothing less than participation in Divine Life, existing in the Big Picture in the way God intended. That is the nourishment offered not to a particular tribe or ethnic group, but to the whole of humanity, indeed to the whole of creation. We could take a moment to pray for faith to recognise that the bread brought up at the Offertory is truly transformed: no longer short-term food like manna in the desert, but ‘the Bread of Life’, the Real Presence of the One who nourishes our humanity, indeed who gives Life *to the world*.

A PRAYER BY SAINT TERESA OF

CALCUTTA - When the sky is grey, remember when you saw it blue. When you feel cold, think of a radiant sun that has warmed you. When you suffer a defeat, remember your successes and your achievements. When you need love, relive your experiences of affection and tenderness. Remember what you have experienced and what you have given with joy. Remember the gifts you have been given, the cuddles and kisses that you have received, the scenery you have enjoyed and the laughter that has poured from you. If you have had this, you can go back and have it all over again, and what you have accomplished, you can win all over again. Rejoice in the good you have and for the good of others, accept them as they are; discard sad and painful memories, and above all have no bitterness, do not hurt yourself anymore. Think about what is good and kind, what is beautiful and true. As you look back over your life, stop at beautiful memories and emotions and re-live them again. Visualize that sunset that touched you. Relive the spontaneous caress that you were given. Enjoy again the peace that you have already known, think about it and live well. All these images are stored in your mind, and only you can decide what to look at again! There is no burden that we are given that we will not have the capacity to carry. Try to live the present by learning from the past; do not carry situations and problems that have already passed. Think about this: What was your biggest challenge 10 years ago? Now it is probably nothing. Now, within 10 years your current problems will not be anything. Why live-in sadness over them?

The Most Holy Eucharist

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

So, they said to him, “Sir, give us this bread always.” Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst.” [John 6:34–35](#)

They were hungry, and they wanted Jesus to perform a miracle like He had recently done. They wanted Him to multiply loaves and fishes for the crowds. Perhaps they were curious or perhaps they were hungry. But Jesus directs them too so much more.

This passage begins Jesus’ discourse on the Bread of Life, which will be read at Sunday Mass for the next few weeks. We will see in this discourse Jesus giving His followers so much more than mere bread and fish. We listen to Him speak of Himself as the true Bread from Heaven. Sadly, many reject this precious teaching and gift and go their own way.

But what about us? How often have we truly pondered these words of Jesus? “I am the Bread of Life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst!” Do we believe this?

Deep within every human heart is a hunger and thirst that longs to be satisfied. We all have this longing and desire. We try to fill it with so many things, but in the end only one thing satisfies. Jesus alone can satiate the deepest longings of our souls. Again, do we believe this? And if we do believe it in our head, do we believe it with our actions? Do we turn to Him as the source of our daily fulfillment and satisfaction? When we go to Mass, do we long to receive Him and love Him and enter into Communion with Him? Perhaps, but perhaps not. Most likely we all need to redirect our desires toward our glorious Saviour, especially as He comes to us in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Reflect, today, upon how deeply we believe in these words of Jesus. Do we regularly meet Him in the Eucharist? Do we allow His presence to consume us as we consume Him? If we cannot say “Yes” to this in a complete and definitive way, resolve today to renew our love for our Lord in this glorious Sacrament.

Lord, I do love You, and I desire You to come and consume me as I consume You in the Most Holy Eucharist. Help me to believe in You and Your presence in this Most Holy Sacrament. May Your divine presence meet my deepest need and fulfill my deepest longings in life. Jesus, I trust in You.
