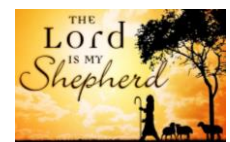

The Lord, the gracious, the merciful, has made a memorial of his wonders; he gives food to those who fear him.

REFLECTIONS- Jesus’ call to ‘come away to some lonely place all by yourselves and rest for a while’ is not just about good work practises and ethical employment policy. It is about humanising our work, making sense of what we do and seeing our work as means to an end, not an end in itself. Mark tells us today that though Jesus was moved to compassion by the needs of the crowd, he also knew that their needs were not the only ones that had to be met. Jesus teaches his disciples and us that the balance between work and rest is an obligation of faith. This applies equally to work inside and outside the family home. So this Sunday’s Gospel carries a critical message for the modern world. Rest, recreation and leisure are not indulgences about which we should feel guilty. They are rights defended by Christ and protect our human dignity.

Alone With Jesus

"Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." [Mark 6:31a](#)

This is an invitation we may need to hear far more than we realize. And it's an invitation that many find hard to accept from Jesus. But take it as a direct invitation offered to us from our Lord. Hear Him say this to you: "You, my child, please do come away by yourself to a deserted place and rest for a while."

There is something very healing and helpful that comes from silence and moments of solitude. There is something about silence and solitude that enables us to get refocused. So often in life we are overwhelmed by busyness. "Busyness" is often a way for the evil one to wear us down and get us off track. It keeps us from the gentle, clear and refreshing voice of God. So how is it that God is inviting you to come away by yourself and rest?

At the heart of this invitation is a longing in Jesus' heart that we rest from those burdens which weigh us down unnecessarily. It's true that there are many good things God calls us to do that can exhaust us. But this "holy exhaustion" is not a bad thing. In fact, being "exhausted" by the will of God actually deepens our faith and fills us with joy. And that joy lightens our burden.

The main reason for our need to "come away" and "rest" is that there are many things in life that are not part of God's will. These are burdens we impose upon ourselves unnecessarily. These burdens, more than anything else, are what we need to rest from. Coming away, alone, with Jesus, is a way of getting refocused and clearing out the clutter of life. It's a way of escaping from our impulses and habits that draw us away from the joyful will of God. So think about this invitation. Think about it practically. Can we find at least ten minutes today to go find silence so as to rest in the arms of Jesus?

Reflect, today, upon how ready and willing we are to accept the invitation from Jesus to come and rest with and in Him. Commit ourselves to doing just that. Make the choice, today, to find time to be alone. From that time of solitude, seek the still, small and silent voice of God. Let the quiet and the peace of God's presence bring clarity and focus to our busy life.

Lord, help me to hear You call me to a time of rest and peace. Help me to seek You and to accept Your gentle invitation. Jesus, I trust in You.

Sacramental Program

We are now taking enrolments for our Sacramental Program. This is a one-year program, for children in Year 3 or older, starting in Term 3 this year. Please call the Parish Office for further details.



Term 3 and 4, 2021

Your child will first receive general Catechesis instruction, to help them gain a greater understanding of who Jesus is, and what we believe in our Church.

Term 1 and 2, 2022

We will give an overview of all the Sacraments, and then your child will be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be received in Term 1, 2022.

We follow the Church's Confirmation and First Eucharist Programs, to prepare your child for receiving these important Sacraments around the end of Term 2, 2022.

Ceremony dates change from year to year, but are generally held in the middle of the year.

Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am

Cost: \$150 for the whole course, which covers the cost of a Youth Bible, Catechesis books, photocopied materials and Ceremonial expenses.
