MEMORIAL CROSS

Set tastefully on the eastern side of The Annunciation Church is the granite Memorial Cross. The Memorial Cross will be lit by night lights and provides the opportunity for family and loved ones to remember those that have departed this world to live an eternal life with The Lord our Father.

The Memorial Cross and the names of the departed will be inscribed on granite plaques placed on the cross and are blessed by our Parish Priest in an annual All Souls Day ceremony.



As a valued Parishioner or simply as part of the Hectorville Catholic Community you have the opportunity to have a granite memorial plaque for your family and or other loved ones to be affixed to the Memorial Cross.

PLEASE NOTE: Each individual plaque is \$330.00. The plaques are in memory of the departed and will be affixed as soon as possible after purchase. Plaques for people who are still living will be affixed at the instructions of relevant family members after the person has passed away.

Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Facing the “Impossible?”

“There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?” Jesus said, “Have the people recline.” [John 6:9–10a](#)

Have you ever been faced with what seems to be an “impossible situation?” Jesus was, but He proved He could overcome any apparent obstacle He wanted to. Sure, He is God, but the fact remains that He can do all things He wills. And He can do so in our lives, too!

This passage above reveals His confidence in His ability to feed many thousands with only five loaves and two fish. Humanly speaking, this is not possible, but divinely speaking, it’s easy.

Jesus’ miracle speaks to His commitment to “feed us” in every way. Yes, this was a feeding with food, but it’s symbolic of Him being able and willing to feed our souls with His grace to face whatever hardship or challenge life throws at us. His grace is enough!

The problem is often twofold. First, we face some challenge in our lives, and we see it as something we do not know how to overcome. This can lead to despair and disillusionment. But when this happens, we must reflect upon miracles like this one and realize that all things are possible for God.

The second problem we often face is the ability to distinguish between God’s will and our own limited ideas. Too often we come up with our own ideas of what we think is good and right, and we start praying for that. But what if God’s idea and will is much different and, of course, much greater?! What if God has a plan that we never could have come up with on our own? The truth is that He does have a far more perfect plan for our lives than we could ever dream up. He knows what is best for us, and He can bring that plan to fruition. For our part, we must seek that plan, surrender to it and have faith in His perfect love, mercy, power and love.

Reflect, today, on our future. What is it that seems to worry us the most? What is it that seems to fill us with anxiety? God has a perfect plan for that situation. Our job is to seek out that plan and trust it will be brought to fruition.

Lord, I know You can do all things and that You will the good in all things. Help me to turn and to surrender to Your perfect divine will. As I surrender to it, help me to have perfect faith that You will bring Your will to fruition. Jesus, I trust in You.

Sacramental Program

We are now taking enrolments for our Sacramental Program. This is a one-year program, for children in Year 3 or older, starting in Term 3 this year. Please call the Parish Office for further details.



Term 3 and 4, 2021

Your child will first receive general Catechesis instruction, to help them gain a greater understanding of who Jesus is, and what we believe in our Church.

Term 1 and 2, 2022

We will give an overview of all the Sacraments, and then your child will be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be received in Term 1, 2022.

We follow the Church's Confirmation and First Eucharist Programs, to prepare your child for receiving these important Sacraments around the end of Term 2, 2022.

Ceremony dates change from year to year, but are generally held in the middle of the year.

Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am

Cost: \$150 for the whole course, which covers the cost of a Youth Bible, Catechesis books, photocopied materials and Ceremonial expenses.
