REFLECTIONS:- Today we consider the call to continue the mission of Jesus by engaging in some form of ministry. The first and the last readings are call narratives; the epistle contains a statement of the faith that undergirds our response to our call; the psalm response celebrates the gracious goodness of God that makes all of this possible. Our call is more than a summons to faith; it is a call to ministry. Isaiah is called in order to be sent; the fishermen are called in order to gather others to Jesus. So, it is with us. We are called to be sent out to the world. This call comes to us in the ordinariness of life. It will usually come to us as we wash our nets or our dishes, as we teach or raise children, as we prepare a brief for trial or examine a patient; as we repair cars or work at the computer. The call of God comes to us in the ordinariness of life.

The Deep Waters of Faith

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C

“Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch.” [Luke 5:4](#)

It's interesting to note that Jesus did not simply tell Peter and the Apostles to put out into the water; rather, He told them to put out into the “deep water.” This is significant.

“Put out into the deep!” What should we take from this? What should we hear Jesus speaking to us? We should hear Him calling us to “lower our nets” in a tireless and committed way so as to draw many others to the Gospel. When Peter and the Apostles did this in the boat, they caught so many fish that their nets were tearing and they were greatly astonished. This is a prophetic action given to us to tell us that we must evangelize with the utmost enthusiasm and zeal, searching far and wide for God's lost sheep.

The world we live in can be hard at times. So many people are lost and confused. Sin is rampant and despair is prevalent. Our world is in desperate need of a Saviour and we are the ones Jesus desires to use to gather a huge catch and to find those in greatest need. Jesus desired the Apostles to catch the fish that were in the deep waters as a way of saying that there are countless souls in our world who are far from God. There are many people “swimming” in an ocean of confusion and pain. It is these people, in particular, that Jesus wants to draw in. It's our responsibility to heed the command of our Lord and to seek them out.

Reflect, today, upon these words of Jesus: “Put out into the deep water.” In what way is Jesus asking this of us? How is it that He is calling us to go out of our comfort zone and “lower our nets?” What is it that He wants of us and how does He desire to use us to further the mission of evangelization. Heed His command and we, too, will be amazed at the good fruit that is born!



St Vincent de Paul Society
good works

Thanks to the significant generosity of our parishioners, the Hectorville Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society was able to assist many needy persons in our community in 2021, as outlined below. We attended to 296 requests for assistance. In almost every case food assistance was asked for, and supermarket and Foodbank vouchers (to the total value of just under \$20,000) were issued, together with parcels of non-perishable food. Nearly 40% of those requests were also for clothing assistance. Many Vinnies gift cards were issued to enable the purchase of clothing and household items from Vinnies shops.

13 blanket and pillow vouchers were issued for use at Vinnies shops.

27 Metrocards, worth \$15 each, were issued.

Two baby layettes were delivered to mothers with newborn babies.

We were able to provide access to Government Emergency Relief Funding, to the total value of \$1,603.59, for 4 people with very high bills.

1 large family received \$355 from the Children's Social Equity Fund to help with school fees.

We delivered 32 Christmas hampers to individuals and families, and 46 children within those families received Christmas gifts. We are extremely grateful to our parishioners for your continued support.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS FOR 2021



We are now taking enrolments for all our programs in Annunciation Church, Hectorville. If you are interested in knowing more, please phone the parish office or email admin@hectorpar.com.au. Further information is also available on our Parish website. (Lessons run during school terms).

SUNDAY SCHOOL - Coordinator: Sr Jimsy (Ph:83369988)

This program is for 5-7 year olds and follows the Catechesis Program "To Know, Worship and Love".
Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am. Cost: \$30 for the year, which covers course materials.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM- Coordinator: Shanti Suppiah (Ph:83369988)

This is approximately a one year program, for children in Year 3 or older, starting in Term 3 this year.

Term 3 and 4, 2022

Your child will first receive general Catechesis instruction, to help them gain a greater understanding of who Jesus is, and what we believe in our Church. We will give an overview of all the Sacraments, and then your child will be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be received in term 1, 2023.

Term 1 and 2, 2023

We follow the Church's Confirmation and First Eucharist Programs, to prepare your child for receiving these important Sacraments around the end of term 2, 2023. Ceremony dates change from year to year, but are generally held in the middle of the year.

Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am

Cost: \$150 for the whole course, which covers the cost of a Youth Bible, Catechesis books, photocopied materials and Ceremonial expenses.

11am Family Mass with Children's Liturgy - follows our Sunday School and Sacramental lesson times, and we greatly encourage your families to take part in our Sunday Eucharistic Celebration, especially as your child prepares to draw closer to Jesus in the Sacraments.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD-

Coordinator: Sue Sachse, Ph: 0431117840.

A religious program based on the Montessori method of education. Children come to one session per week. During a session children learn about God through prayer, scripture and liturgy. They are able to work with models like the Good Shepherd, the Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity, Last Supper. We have a small altar with replica child-size Mass vessels.

Level 1 Session times, for 3-6 yrs olds:

Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday mornings, 10.00am – 12noon, Saturday afternoons, 1-3pm

Level 2 Sessions times, for 6-7 yrs olds:

(Term 1 will be a transition term between Level 1 and 2. Children new to the program can start at age 6 or 7 in this session, but will need to spend some time with Level 1 works first). Wednesday afternoons, 3.30-5.30pm / Saturday afternoons, 3.30-5.30pm

Cost: \$10 per week, paid per term if possible.
