

It Takes a Lot of Faith!

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C

"Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude and insult you, and denounce your name as evil on account of the Son of Man. Rejoice and leap for joy on that day! Behold, your reward will be great in heaven." Luke 6:22-23

It takes a lot of faith to "rejoice and leap for joy" after experiencing hatred and persecution from another. Even when one is persecuted on account of his/her faith in Christ, it takes a lot of faith and a lot of love to sincerely rejoice.

But with that said, this level of faith and love is possible! If it were not, our Lord would not have given this teaching. It is a teaching to live the highest ideal. It's a calling to live in Beatitude.

Though it would be worth it to spend time on each and every one of the Beatitudes and to try to apply them to our lives, it's also helpful to look at the more general fact that Jesus does not call us to mediocrity; rather, He calls us to the heights of perfection. It is within those heights that our souls find the greatest reward.

Reflect, today, upon this Beatitude. Perhaps we have never experienced persecution and hatred as a result of following Jesus. But even if we haven't, try to put ourselves into this situation and try to honestly discover how we would react. Would we be able to allow persecution to "roll off our back" so to speak? Would we be able to accept injustice in our life without allowing it to disturb our interior peace? Or would we turn bitter and angry as a result of the hurt we would feel?

Try to put our eyes upon the ideals of the Christian life. If we aim for anything less, we run the risk of actually attaining that lower goal. But if we put our eyes upon the high calling of the Beatitudes, then we will find that our Lord will continually draw us closer to His heart, cleansing us, strengthening us, filling us with more faith, hope and love, and bringing us to an increasingly blessed level of holiness. It's worth it to aim for the ideal!

Lord of perfection, please make me holy. Help me to keep my eyes upon You and upon the virtues and Beatitudes that You call me to live. May I never settle for a mediocre life. Instead, may I strive only for a life of perfection and holiness making You the center of all I long for.

Jesus, I trust in You.

Children's programs for 2022

We are now taking enrolments for all our programs in Annunciation Church, Hectorville. If you are interested in knowing more, please phone the parish office or email admin@hectorpar.com.au.Further information is also available on our Parish website. (Lessons run during school terms).

SUNDAY SCHOOL Coordinator: Sr Jimsy(Ph:83369988)

This program is for 5-7 year old's and follows the Catechesis Program "To Know, Worship and Love". Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am. Cost: \$30 for the year, which covers course materials.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM- Coordinator: Shanti Suppiah (Ph:83369988)

This is approximately a one year program, for children in Year 3 or older, starting in Term 3 this year.

Term 3 and 4, 2022

Your child will first receive general Catechesis instruction, to help them gain a greater understanding of who Jesus is, and what we believe in our Church. We will give an overview of all the Sacraments, and then your child will be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be received in term 1, 2023.

Term 1 and 2, 2023

We follow the Church's Confirmation and First Eucharist Programs, to prepare your child for receiving these important Sacraments around the end of term 2, 2023. Ceremony dates change from year to year, but are generally held in the middle of the year.

Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am

Cost: \$150 for the whole course, which covers the cost of a Youth Bible, Catechesis books, photocopied materials and Ceremonial expenses.

<u>11am Family Mass with Children's Liturgy</u> - follows our Sunday School and Sacramental lesson times, and we greatly encourage your families to take part in our Sunday Eucharistic Celebration, especially as your child prepares to draw closer to Jesus in the Sacraments.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD-

Coordinator: Sue Sachse, Ph: 0431117840.

A religious program based on the Montessori method of education. Children come to one session per week. During a session children learn about God through prayer, scripture and liturgy. They are able to work with models like the Good Shepherd, the Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity, Last Supper. We have a small altar with replica child-size Mass vessels.

Level 1 Session times, for 3-6 yrs olds:

Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday mornings, 10.00am – 12noon, Saturday afternoons, 1-3pm

Level 2 Sessions times, for 6-7 yrs olds:

(Term 1 will be a transition term between Level 1 and 2. Children new to the program can start at age 6 or 7 in this session, but will need to spend some time with Level 1 works first). Wednesday afternoons, 3.30-5.30pm / Saturday afternoons, 3.30-5.30pm

Cost: \$10 per week, paid per term if possible.
