FROM THE VICAR GENERAL

I write to inform the people of the Hectorville Parish that **Fr Pat Lopresti** has been diagnosed with chronic irritation of the larynx and with medication and therapy will be absent from the parish for a minimum of 4 weeks. Unfortunately, it may take up to 3 months for his full recovery. Please continue to pray for his full return to health.

This situation places enormous pressure on **Fr Jeevan** who continues to carry a heavy workload in the parish. Unfortunately, there is no free priest to send to Hectorville at this time. I wish it were otherwise. However, **Fr Anthoni Adimai** as Administrator of the Cathedral will support the parish with weekday, Sunday, Funeral and Month Minds Masses as much as possible. I offer my personal support as well.

This is far from an ideal situation, but one that we all need to accept until the future becomes clearer. I ask for your understanding and realisation that in the short term all your expectations for ministry may not be able to be met. I especially ask for your care and support for your Parish Priest Fr Jeevan who has for some time now carried a considerable burden.

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

“All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” Matthew 28:18-20 (Year B Gospel)

The Trinity! The inner life of God! The Greatest Mystery of our Faith!

We all are used to the idea that there is one God. And we fully accept that this one God is the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. First, we need to understand that God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are three divine Persons. Each one distinct from the other. Each Person has a perfect intellect and free will. Each one is capable of knowing and loving to a perfect degree.

But it is this “perfection” of their ability to know and love that makes them one. They each share in the one divine nature and, within that divine nature, are perfectly united. This means that each one knows and loves the other perfectly. And that knowledge (an act of their perfect intellect) and love (an act of their perfect will) brings about a unity so profound and deep that they live and act as one God.

What's also inspiring to know and understand is that the unity they share by their mutual knowledge and love also offers each one of them perfect fulfillment as a Person. This shows that “personhood” is fulfilled by unity. What a wonderful lesson this is for each of us. We are not God, but we are made in God's image and likeness. Therefore, we find fulfillment in the same way that God does. Specifically, we find fulfillment in life by our love of others and our free-will choice to enter into a knowledge of each person, forming a communion with them.

This will take on different forms depending upon our relationships. Of course, husband and wife are called to share in the deepest unity in imitation of the life of God. But all relationships are called to share in God's life in their own unique way. Reflect, today, as we celebrate this Trinity Sunday, on the relationships to which God has called us. Certainly, we will all find areas in which to grow. Make a commitment to take another step deeper and, in that step of love, allow God to give us a greater fulfillment as a result.

Sacramental Program

We are now taking enrolments for our Sacramental Program. This is a one-year program, for children in Year 3 or older, starting in Term 3 this year.



Term 3 and 4, 2022

Your child will first receive general Catechesis instruction, to help them gain a greater understanding of who Jesus is, and what we believe in our Church.

Term 1 and 2, 2023

We will give an overview of all the Sacraments, and then your child will be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be received in Term 1, 2023.

We follow the Church's Confirmation and First Eucharist Programs, to prepare your child for receiving these important Sacraments around the end of Term 2, 2023.

Ceremony dates change from year to year, but are generally held in the middle of the year.

Session times: Sunday mornings, 9.30am – 10.30am

Cost: \$150 for the whole course, which covers the cost of a Youth Bible, Catechesis books, photocopied materials and Ceremonial expenses.
