





AFRICA FOOD CRISIS APPEAL

After three years of poor rainfall, some of the worst locust plagues seen in decades, and ongoing conflict, displacement and the impacts of COVID-19, millions of people are facing hunger and even starvation across the Horn of Africa. According to the recently released Global Report on Food Crises, nearly 193 million people are in need of urgent assistance, an increase of nearly 40 million since 2020. Caritas Australia has launched the Africa Food to provide urgently needed Crisis Appeal humanitarian aid to countries in the Horn of Africa, including Ethiopia, Somalia and Eritrea. Through partners on the ground, donations to Caritas Australia's Africa Food Crisis appeal will go towards food distributions, support for children impacted by malnutrition, clean drinking water, cash transfers to households at risk of poverty, hygiene supplies as well as seeds and household items for families that have been displaced by conflict.

We will give an overview of all the Sacraments, and then your child will be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be received in Term 1, 2023.

We follow the Church's Confirmation and First Eucharist Programs, to prepare your child for receiving these important Sacraments around the end of Term 2, 2023.

Ceremony dates change from year to year, but are generally held in the middle of the year.
