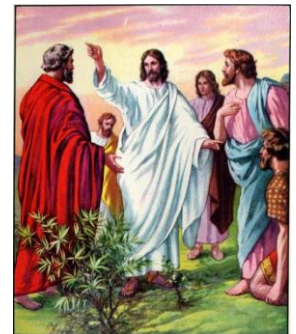

Have you ever been in situation where you seem to be banging your head against a brick wall? You have explained a situation a hundred times but your companion, child, colleague doggedly refuse to see it your way! The simple answer is that they have a different way of looking at the world. They are just different! The Enneagram Personality System enables people to determine their unique perception of the world and to also understand why they came to believe in it – and what motivates them. To make this manageable, these perceptions have been grouped into nine sectors which is the basis for the nine Enneagram types. As we are all different we will have some characteristics of all nine types although one type will predominate. Through these two introductory workshops, participants will discover the way this system operates and also to find their own personality type. National Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Sunday today

Every year, on the first Sunday in July, Catholics come together across Australia to acknowledge and celebrate the gifts of Australia's First Peoples in the Catholic Church. NAIDOC has a theme this year of **'Get up, Stand up, Show up'**.

In today's Gospel Jesus tells us to pray to ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest. If we truly want more labourers for the vineyard that produces the Good News of life in abundance for all, the same vineyard that also tells the Jesus story through the eyes and hearts of Aboriginals and Torres Strait Islanders, then praying is only one way to do this.

Labourers for the harvest of the Lord do exactly that – they labour or work for the Lord, and that can take the form of getting up and being active. There is much we can do as Christian people to address issues that affect our First Nations sisters and brothers.

Jesus told those he encountered many things in parables. He used stories to illustrate the greatest examples of how best to live your life in the service of others. He challenged his followers by speaking directly about those on the margins and those the world most commonly ignores. Many were astounded by the things Jesus said and did and they left all behind and followed him.
