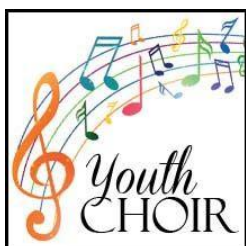

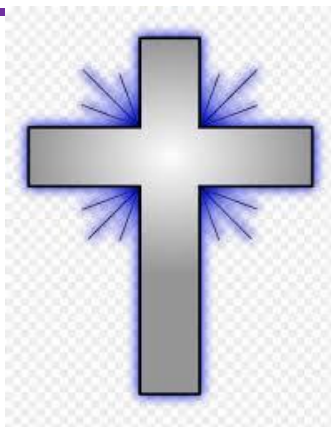
Memorial Cross and Plaques
