BACKGROUND TO TODAY'S GOSPEL READING



This week's gospel passage picks up one of the major themes that runs throughout the gospel of Luke: the message of salvation is not reserved exclusively for the Jews, but is for all people; Jew and Gentile alike.

A number of times in this gospel, the writer makes a point of having Jesus relate this controversial and fairly unpopular message to his audience. Today's gospel makes clear that to gain salvation, you have to do more than just show up! Like those knocking on the locked door and claiming friendship, we can't just turn up at the last minute and expect to be received.

Salvation – entrance into the kingdom of God – belongs to those who accept the message of Jesus and act on it for the rest of their lives.

The gospel makes plain to the Jewish people of the time that unless they accept the message of Jesus and act upon it, they will get a terrible shock ('weeping and grinding of teeth') at the coming of the kingdom. Those who believe in name only will find themselves looking in from the outside and will see the greatest prophets in the kingdom while they themselves are denied access. To further make the point, they are told that people from east and west, north and south will be welcomed into the feast of the kingdom. References to people from the four points of the compass always indicate people from other lands – non-Jews. Jesus tells his audience that people who are faithful to his message, even though they may be Gentile, will gain salvation before anyone who thinks they deserve it because of their birth or title. The kingdom must be earned through faithful effort, not by just turning up and claiming to be a believer.

MONDAY 22nd AUGUST WE CELEBRATE THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



The Story of the Queenship of Mary


Pope Pius XII established this feast in 1954. But Mary's queenship has roots in Scripture. At the Annunciation, Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "Mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, she is closely associated with Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.

In the fourth century Saint Ephrem called Mary "Lady" and "Queen." Later Church fathers and doctors continued to use the title. Hymns of the 11th to 13th centuries address Mary as queen: "Hail, Holy Queen," "Hail, Queen of Heaven," "Queen of Heaven." The Dominican rosary and the Franciscan crown as well as numerous invocations in Mary's litany celebrate her queenship.

The feast is a logical follow-up to the Assumption, and is now celebrated on the octave day of that feast. In his 1954 encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pius XII points out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God, because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, because of her preeminent perfection, and because of her intercessory power.

Blessed Mother, conceived without sin, Pray for us.

HAVE YOU SEEN THE CHOSEN?



The Chosen is a drama series created, directed and co-written by American filmmaker Dallas Jenkins. It is the *first multi-season series* about the life and ministry of Jesus of Nazareth.

Jenkins, the series' creator, wanted to create a series about Jesus that could be "binge watched", and hoped to distinguish the new series from previous portrayals of Jesus by crafting a multi-season, episode-based story. Jenkins' intention was not only to dig deeper into the people who encountered Jesus and to see Jesus through the eyes of those who met him, but also to show him in a way that is more "personal, intimate, immediate". The series portrays Jesus "through the eyes of those who met him".

Set in 1st century Israel, the series revolves around Jesus and the different people who met and followed him. The series stars Catholic actor Jonathan Roumie as Jesus, alongside a fantastic cast playing the roles of the apostles, Mary Magdalene and Mother Mary among others.

Season one was the *top crowd-funded TV series or film project of all time*. As of 2021, viewers had contributed \$40 million towards its production. It is also the only show with 100% rating on Rotten Tomatoes. The show is available on streaming platforms like Angel Studios, Tubi TV or simply scan the QR code below or go to
