### Reflection

The Jesus Prayer has its origin in today’s Gospel parable. The text of the prayer is simple: “Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me a sinner”. Prayed since the 6<sup>th</sup> century, the modern technique associated with this prayer – meditation and repetition - didn’t come into use until the 14<sup>th</sup> century. Like any prayer, the point isn’t to perfect the technique but to find the right spirit.

The tax collector in the parable had the right spirit, even he couldn’t imagine the technique that history would form around his prayer. He simply bowed his head, acknowledged his sins, and counted on God’s mercy. The Pharisee, who had more style and undoubtedly greater technique, gave himself over to self-celebration, reporting his good deeds in the event God might have missed them. In the process, he missed the heart of prayer, which is humility.
