The Hectorville Parish is seeking a suitably qualified Parish Secretary to join the Parish Team.

This will be a job share arrangement between two persons working 5 days per week in total, 9am to 3pm daily. Working days will be negotiated with the two successful applicants.

The Parish Secretary assists the Parish Priest with the administration of the Parish Office and provides administration support to Clergy and various Parish Committees.

This position requires previous administrative support experience, and good interpersonal and communication skills to liaise with parishioners and external parties. The successful applicant will have high level computer skills (expertise in the Microsoft Office suite, ability to upload and maintain website information and Publisher skills an advantage. Good teamwork, strong organisational skills and the willingness to perform other general duties as assigned by the Parish Priest essential.

The Parish Secretary will be the first point of contact for visitors, parishioners, volunteers and all those making contact with the Parish Office.

Excellent interpersonal and communication skills are essential together with the ability to work in a team whilst being autonomous and able to use initiative. Interacting with the Italian community in the Parish is a significant part of the role so the ability to speak and understand Italian is an advantage but not essential

The successful applicants will be strongly committed to the Catholic ethos.

Endurance is more than human effort and
perseverance. It is a supernatural gift of the Holy
Spirit which enables us to bear up under trials,
temptations, and persecution. Endurance is
strengthened with hope – the supernatural assurance
that we will see God face to face and inherit all the
promises he has made. Jesus is our supreme model
and hero who endured the cross for our sake
(Hebrews 12:2). Jesus willingly shed his blood for
our sake and for our salvation and he calls us to love
and to die to ourselves in like manner. God may call
some of us to be martyrs for our faith. But for most
of us, our call is to be 'dry' martyrs who bear
testimony to the joy and power of the gospel in the

loving their enemies, being joyful in suffering, patient
in adversity, pardoning injuries, and showing

helpless. Jesus tells us that we do not need to fear
our adversaries. God will give us sufficient grace,
strength, and wisdom to face any trial and to answer
any challenge to our faith. Are you eager to bear
witness to the joy and freedom of the gospel? "Lord
Jesus, by your cross you have redeemed the world.
Fill me with joy and confidence and make me a bold
witness of your saving truth that others may know
the joy and freedom of the gospel."
