The Hectorville Parish is seeking a suitably qualified Parish Secretary to join the Parish Team.

This will be a job share arrangement between two persons working 5 days per week in total, 9am to 3pm daily. Working days will be negotiated with the two successful applicants.

The Parish Secretary assists the Parish Priest with the administration of the Parish Office and provides administration support to Clergy and various Parish Committees.

This position requires previous administrative support experience, and good interpersonal and communication skills to liase with parishioners and external parties. The successful applicant will have high level computer skills (expertise in the Microsoft Office suite, ability to upload and maintain website information and Publisher skills an advantage. Good teamwork, strong organisational skills and the willingness to perform other general duties as assigned by the Parish Priest essential.

The Parish Secretary will be the first point of contact for visitors, parishioners, volunteers and all those making contact with the Parish Office.

Excellent interpersonal and communication skills are essential together with the ability to work in a team whilst being autonomous and able to use initiative. Interacting with the Italian community in the Parish is a significant part of the role so the ability to speak and understand Italian is a advantage but not essential

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Christ the King strengthens us not only so that each of us can get to Heaven. He strengthens us through His Body and Blood, soul and divinity so that we might lead our daily lives in Him. We accept the love of God at Holy Mass so that we'll be strong enough to love everyone in this fallen world with the very love of God.

Of course, love is a notoriously slippery term. Some people just think of love as an emotion or feeling. But Christ the King shows us on the Cross that divine love actually is self-sacrifice. If, when we leave Holy Mass, we wonder about how we can love others better, then we need to remember the ready answer that the Church offers us. The Church points our attention towards the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. Christ calls us to leave His Church, filled with the strength of His Body and Blood, soul and divinity, in order to share that love concretely with those in the world.

The **First Reading** describes the anointing of David as King of Israel. His people describe him as 'one of us', a person who has led and shepherded them.

The Gospel describes the reactions of people to the crucifixion of Jesus. We witness the humility of the thief who recognizes his poverty and wrongdoing, and quietly asks Jesus to remember him.

St Paul speaks of the grace and joy that has come to us through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. In Christ, we gain our freedom through the forgiveness of our sin (**Second Reading**).
