REFLECTION

John the Baptist shifts from the Person of Christ to The Work of Christ. The reason is that the Person of Christ shows that He is the only possible candidate to be the Messiah. In other words, the qualifications to be the Messiah are only met in Jesus. Now, John is about to show us that the works Jesus will do also point to Him being the Messiah because these are the very things the Messiah is to be doing.

<u>Jesus is the Lamb of God</u> "The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God"

At the end of John's Gospel he refers to all the books that could have been written that could contain the works and words of Jesus. His conclusion was that the entire earth could not contain the books. So, if there is a world full of things about Jesus then it should get our attention that the very first thing John the Baptist says about Jesus is that He is the Lamb of God. The entire OT is written with this concept in mind.
