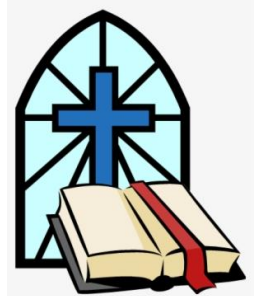

REFLECTION

That’s what makes us Catholic and why today we need to listen again and very carefully, to Paul’s admonition, ‘I beg you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you be in agreement and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and purpose.’ To the degree to which we live this out in our communion with our local successor to the Apostles, the more chance all members of the Church have to use the energy and gifts given at baptism to do what Christ wants of the Church; to change the world for good and be a beacon of the saving Christ’s gifts – faith, hope and charity.

A GATHERING WITH SISTER NATHALIE BECQUART XMCJ



Sister Nathalie Becquart is the Undersecretary to the Secretary of the Synod on Synodality at the Vatican. she is the first woman in history to hold such a position, and the first woman to be given voting power at a Synod of Bishops. She was also recently named as one of the BBC's top 100 women of 2022.

Sister Nathalie has asked to visit the Archdiocese of Adelaide in part to learn about our experiences of becoming a more Synodal Church and to encourage us in our own efforts.

This is a unique and important opportunity for each of us to connect more closely with Pope Francis' vision for a Church that is *Together on the Way*. At the 2022 Diocesan Assembly in October, there was a particular emphasis on Synodality and mission, this gathering with Sister Nathalie will assist with this work. Those who attended the Diocesan Assembly, Parish Priests and all Clergy, Pastoral Associates, members of Parish Pastoral Councils, School leadership and leaders of communities are especially invited to attend this gathering

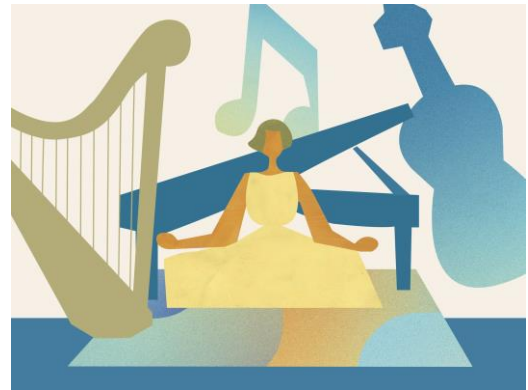

REFLECTION

Jesus meets people while they are doing their ordinary daily work of fishing and mending their nets on the sea shore. They weren't on their knees praying in the temple or the synagogue. Jesus called these men by their own names, so he must have seen them before and known them. Today in the same way, Jesus continues to call us by our name. In the Old Testament, there are two beautiful pieces of scripture through which God says, *I have called you by your name, you are mine and that I have written your name on the palms of my hands*. This is how personally and intimately God knows and loves each of us.
