## REFLECTION

Today’s reading brings us face to face with temptation, and a call to surrender ultimately to the graciousness of God’s love as we enter more fully into the Lenten Season. Pope Francis tells us why prayer is so important in lent. Even more than a duty, prayer is an expression of our need to respond to God’s love which always precedes and sustains us. Christians pray in the knowledge that, although unworthy, we are still loved. Prayer can take any number of different forms, but what truly matters in God’s eyes is that it penetrates deep within us and chips away at our hardness of heart, in order to convert us ever more fully to God and to his will.

Will be celebrated in English every Wednesday evening at **7.00pm** in the Annunciation Church beginning **Wednesday, 1st March 2023**. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year: the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year.

Laxmi, 16, lives in in Jajarkot, a remote district in Nepal where almost half of the population live below the poverty line. Tragedy struck when Laxmi was 10 years old and her father passed away. Her father worked hard to pay for his children's education and after losing him Laxmi was at risk of falling further into extreme poverty.
