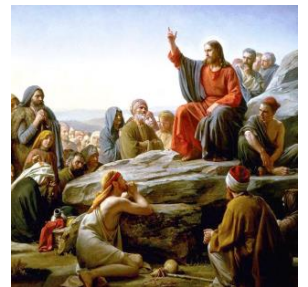

The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year: the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year.
