This is a 12 month programme beginning in Term 3, Sunday 30th July 2023. It is open to children in year 3 at school or older.

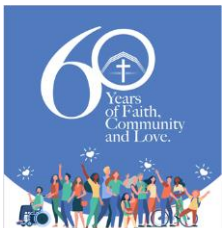

A theology of the Home

When the Israelites escaped from slavery in Egypt, they wandered for forty years to find the promised land. It was a trip that should have only taken a few weeks but under God's watchful care it ended up taking a lot longer. And maybe we know what this is like, that rising interest rates and house prices means we keep looking but never finding a home.

But just as God did not want Israel to aimlessly wander for ever, so too, he wants us to find a home.

And this is why he has given us the Church, our true home on earth, the place where we can always find him.

No matter if we're renting, or paying off a mortgage, or comfortably living in our own home, the Church is our true home that offers us now and in eternity those things we long for. Rest, comfort, belonging, nourishment, love. It's all to be found in the Church. Now typically there is something in a Church that each of us comes to love. It's probably different for each of us, but I love the statue of our Lady at the side altar of our Church. Just to see her and touch her, instantly gives me peace, it raises my heart to heaven, and often times brings a lump to my throat. This simple statue brings my heart to heaven while my feet are on earth.

And something similar happens in our homes, there's something that we're attracted to, that makes us feel at home. And it's more than just nice towels and bedding. Maybe it's a favourite chair or mug, or some heirloom handed down to us. Things in our home really can make the past present again, and kindle in our hearts a longing for the future and what's to come. So, one of the ways to make our homes more Catholic is by having little reminders of the eternal, little windows into the past and the future.

Practical tip

It is customary that Catholics have a crucifix in their house, normally this is placed at the entrance or somewhere prominent like the kitchen or dining room. This is a beautiful thing to do, but why stop there? What if every room had a crucifix or a picture of Mary or another of your favourite saints? What if every room had something to help you remember the divine?

Just like family photos make a home more homely, and connect us to our past, present and our future, so too, statues, images of the saints, holy cards, photos of our first holy communion or marriage, all help to make our home a place where we long for the Father's home.
